## DVD 502 DVD PLAYER



Thank you for purchasing the new DVD 502 player. For perfect operation and security, read the manual carefully and keep it for future reference.



# I. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS



**Read all the safety instructions before first use of your DVD Player.**

## **Power source**

You should only plug the appliance into a 100V to 240VAC, 50Hz supply.

## **Safety considerations**

- Position the power supply lead and other leads so that they are not likely to be walked on or pinched by things placed on or against them.
- Do not use the appliance in humid or damp conditions. Do not allow the appliance to get wet, i.e. dripping or splashing, as this may be dangerous. Do not place water filled object, such as vases, on top of the appliance.
- Make sure that no naked flame sources, such as candles, are placed on top of the appliance.

## **Cleaning**

Unplug the appliance before you clean it.

- Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners.
- Clean your appliance with a soft damp (not wet) cloth.

## **Ventilation**

- Any slots and opening on the appliance are for ventilation. Do not cover or block them as it could lead to overheating.
- NEVER let children push anything into the holes or slots on the case.

## **Servicing**

There are no user serviceable parts in your DVD player.

When servicing, refer to qualified service personnel.

## **Battery disposal**

Please ensure batteries are disposed of safely.

## **Electrical information**

Make ensure that the voltage of your electricity supply is the same as that indicated on the rear plate. This appliance may be fitted with a non-rewireable plug. If you need to change the fuse in a non-rewireable, the fuse cover must be refitted. If the fuse cover is lost or damaged, the plug must not be used until a replacement is obtained (available from the appliance manufacturers). It is important that the colour of the replacement fuse cover corresponds with the colour marking on the base of the plug.

If the plug has to be changed because it is not suitable for your socket, or becomes damaged, it should be removed and an appropriate plug fitted following the wiring instructions below. The plug removed must be disposed of safely as insertion into a main socket is likely to cause an electrical hazard.

If a 3 Amp (BS1363) plug is used, a 3 Amp fuse (BS1362) must be fitted, or if any other type of plug is used a 3 Amp fuse must be fitted, either in the plug, adaptor or on the distribution board.

## II. GETTING STARTED

**Remove your DVD player carefully from the box, You may wish to store the packaging for future use.**

### **In the box**

Included in this package should be:

- DVD Player
- Remote control
- Batteries x 2 for remote control
- User guide
- Quick start guide items.

Read these instructions before use.

### **Switching on**

#### **Main power**

Connect the 2-pin main plug into the main socket and switch on.

Press the power button on the front of the unit to turn the

DVD player on or off.

### **Using the remote control**

#### **Installing the batteries**

Remove the battery cover. Insert two AAA size batteries in the compartment. Refer to the diagram in the battery compartment for correct installation of the batteries.

#### **Control DVD player**

Point it at the front of the DVD player; press the relevant button to choose demand function.

The remote control will work up to 6 metres from the DVD and at an angle of up to 45 degrees.

Do not block the path of the beam from the remote control to the DVD, Dark walls direct sunlight or bright light will reduce the remote control sensitivity.

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## III. FEATURES

### 1. OUTSTANDING SOUND QUALITY

Features high quality sound, can play DVD or CD discs at home, reproduce high quality sound effects.

### 2. HIGH DEFINITION

The unit adopts MPEG2 coding format and brings the horizontal resolution over 500 lines

### 3. UNIQUE FUNCTIONS

Multi-angle, multi-language and multi-story features bring you unique trick functions.

Parent lock makes it easy to control the content of discs.

### 4. SCREEN

Both ordinary screen and wide (16:9) screen are available.

### 5. COMPATIBILITY

The unit can play DVD discs, and is compatible with Super-VCD, VCD, CD, CD-R, CD-RW and MP3 discs.

### 6. ZOOM

It can enlarge picture twice or four times as big.

### 7. NINE-PICTURE DIGEST

It can look through the content of discs and select to play.

### 8. TRICK-PLAY

Fast forward, fast reverse, slow play, frame play, repeat play and program play.

### 9. TIME SEARCH

It can search a specific part on a disc, especially well for watching fiction movies.

### 10. RESUME PLAY

It can memorize the position where the disc is stopped and resume playback.

### 11. CONTENT DISPLAY

It adopts coloured fluorescent display and English or other national OSD (On Screen Display), make the disc content clearer.








### 12. VIDEO OUTPUT

## V. BEFORE OPERATION

### SECURITY

- Before operation, check if the voltage of the unit is in line with the local voltage.
- Hold the plug to disconnect it from the mains outlet. Do not pull the power cord.
- When the plug of the unit is connected to the mains outlet, the unit will be still connected to AC even if the power is turned off.
- Disconnect the plug as soon as liquid or objects enter the unit. The unit cannot be used until being checked by experts.
- Do not open the cabinet. Laser rays employed by the unit may damage eyes. Any servicing should be done by qualified service personnel.

### PLACEMENT

- Put the unit where ventilation is good enough to prevent overheating.
- Never put the unit in direct sunlight or near heat sources.
- Place the unit horizontally, never put any heavy object

on the unit.

- To protect the pickup, do not put the unit where there is much dust. If there is dust on the pickup, use a cleaning disc to clean it.
- Refer to the operation instructions of the cleaning disc you bought.

### CONDENSATION

Moisture will appear on the pickup lens in the following cases:

- The unit is suddenly moved from a cold place to a warm place.
- The unit is put in a room with a heater, or in cold air from an air-conditioner.
- Use the unit in a humid place. In these cases, the unit cannot work. Unload the disc and leave the unit on for about one hour to evaporate the water.

## VI. PRECAUTIONS FOR DISCS

### HANDLING DISC

- To keep the disc clean, do not touch the play sides of the disc.
- Do not attach paper or tape to the disc.
- Keep the disc away from direct sunlight or heat sources.
- Store the disc in a disc case after playback.

### CLEANING DISC

- Before playback, wipe the disc outwards from the centre with clean cloth.
- Do not use any type of solvent such as thinner, benzene, commercially available cleaners or antistatic spray.

## VII. PREPARATIONS BEFORE OPERATION

### USE REMOTE CONTROL

1. Open the battery compartment.
2. Insert two AAA batteries, make sure to match “+” and “-” of the batteries to the marks in the battery compartment.
3. Close the battery compartment.

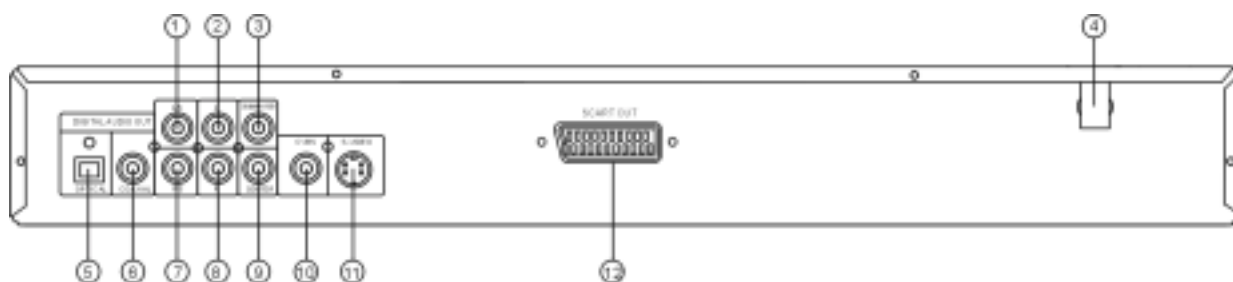
4. Point the remote control at the remote sensor, operate in the range of up to 8 meters away from the front of the remote sensor. Make sure there is no barrier between them.

#### Notes:

1. Batteries can last for about 6 months generally. Change the batteries of the remote control if it does not work.
2. If the remote control is not used for a long time, remove the batteries to prevent battery leakage.

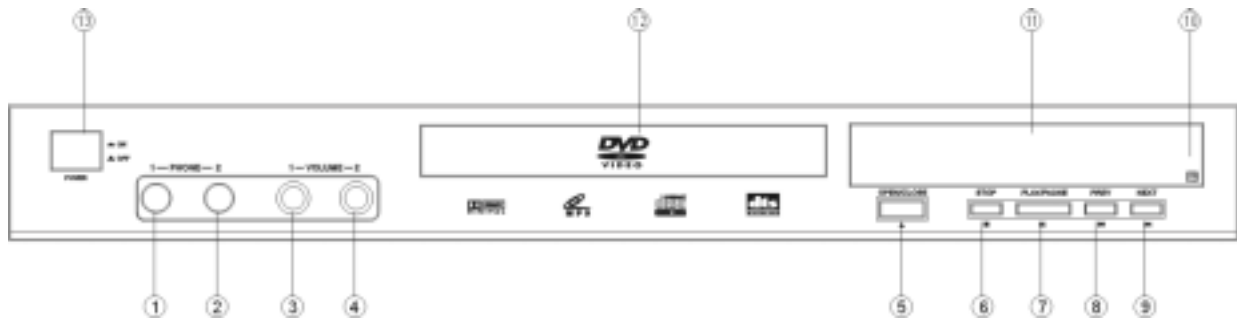

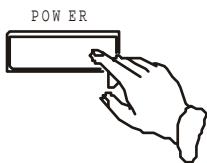
## VIII. BASIC OPERATIONS

### PLAY DISCS

1. Push **POWER** on the TV, select AV mode (TV).



2. Connect the DVD player to the power. Push the "POWER" Button.



3. Push **▲** to open the disc tray and load a disc with the label side up.
4. Push **▲** again to close the disc tray. The unit begins to read the disc.

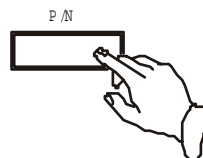

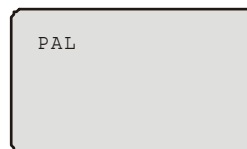

### PAL/NTSC SETTING

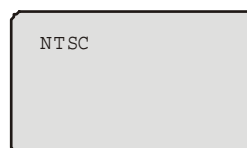
According to the system of the TV to be connected, set the system of the unit to make it match the TV.



1. If the system of the TV is PAL: Push P/N, select PAL. The screen shows:

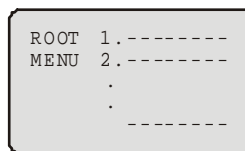
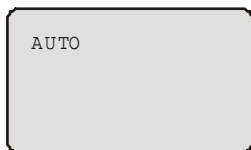


2. If the system of the TV is NTSC: Push P/N, select NTSC. The screen shows:



3. If the TV is multi-system, push **P/N** to select AUTO.

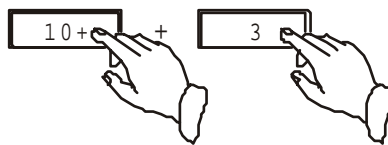


Example: select track 13.

1. Push **▶▶** to enter the next menu.



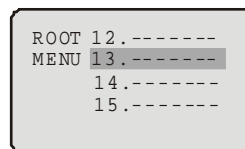
2. Push number buttons to select directly.



Pressing 10+ one time means adding 10. If select tracks greater 19, please press 10+ twice, and then press 1 to 9 button. It is the similarity for selecting tracks greater 29 or more.

You can also do as follows:

1. Push **▼** to select track 13.



2. Push **▶▶** to start playing the selected tracks.

Push **TITLE** once to return to the title menu. Push it again to return to the current playback.

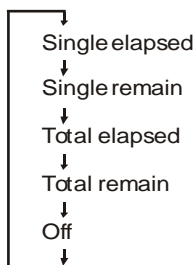

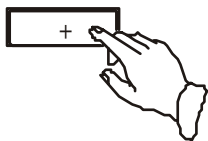

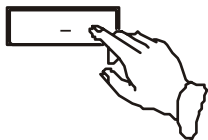
## VOLUME CONTROL

Push **VOLUME** on the TV or amplifier to adjust the volume.

Also you can push **VOLUME** key on the remote control to adjust volume. Push "+" to raise the volume.



Push "-" to lower the volume.



## DVD MENU PLAY

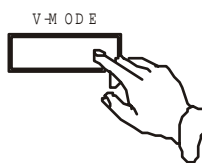
Some DVD discs have title menus and chapter menus.

Push **MENU** or **TITLE**, the screen shows the menu. Use the direction buttons to select the desired item, then press **▶▶**.

Push **▶▶** to see the next page, select with number buttons and direction buttons.

## VIDEO MODE SELECT

Pressing button VIDEO to switch TV output mode: Composite video, or SCART output. When using Composite video, connect video cable to VIDEO port. When using SCART, connect 21-pin SCART cable to SCART socket. Please be noted that TV set must have SCART port if using SCART output. In the setup menu, one can preset video mode to one of three modes. Then, when power on, the DVD video will output in the default mode.

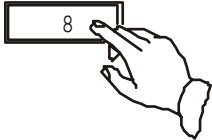

## SELECT WITH DIGITAL BUTTON

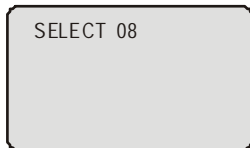
After loading a disc, push digital button to select tracks.

1. If the track number is less than 10, just push a button among 1-10.



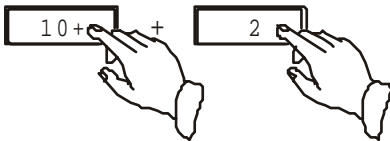

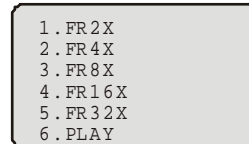
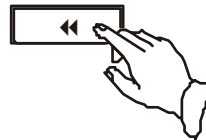
When playing disc, you may play it fast forward or reverse it quickly to find what you need.

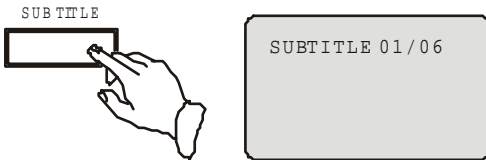
## SELECT SUBTITLES

When play a multi-subtitle DVD or Super-VCD, you may select one subtitle to show it on the screen.

### DVD

1. Push **SUBTITLE** to select one.

2. Remove the subtitle.

Push **SUBTITLE** until the screen shows "SUBTITLE OFF"

Notes:

- For some discs, subtitles cannot be removed
- Different discs have the different languages of subtitles.
- If the subtitles of discs cannot be selected, push **SUBTITLE**, the screen shows "OFF".

### Super-VCD

A super-VCD has only four channels for recording. So it has four subtitles at the most.

Push **SUBTITLE**, the screen shows orderly:

- SUBTITLE 1
- SUBTITLE 2
- SUBTITLE 3
- SUBTITLE 4
- SUBTITLE OFF

You may select a subtitle, as you need. Some discs may not have "SUBTITLE OFF" function.

## SELECT ANGLE

Some discs have images with different screen angles, you may select among them. For example, when you watch a running train, you may select to watch it from the front, the left window or the right window without stopping it.

Example:

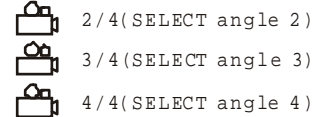
A DVD has four screen angles at your option.

1. Push **ANGLE** to select ANGLE.

2. Push **ANGLE** to select other angles, the screen shows respectively:



3. Resume normal playback.

Push **ANGLE** until there is no display on the screen.

## TIME SEARCH

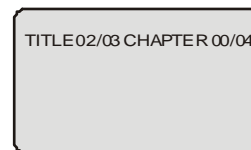
You may directly enter a time, title or chapter number to search fast on a disc. The unit plays from the point.

You can only enter a time to search the content at the time.

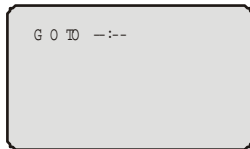

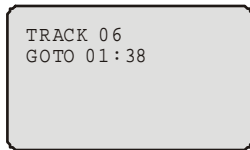

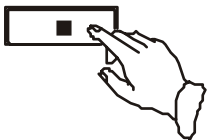

## MEMORY PLAY

(For VCD, SVCD, CD only)

The unit can memorize the last point where it stops and resume playback from there.

- 1. Push **STOP** to stop playing.



- 2. Push **MEMORY** to resume playback.

- ✧ This function does not work for any programmed playback.

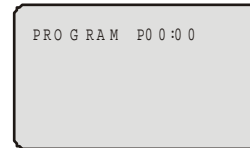

## PROGRAM PLAY

You may program the tracks on a disc and play them in the programmed order.

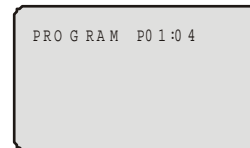

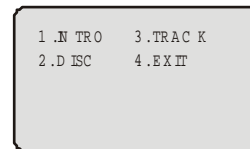

This function can be used to look through the content of a track or a disc.

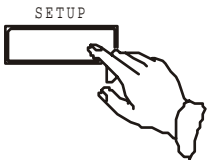

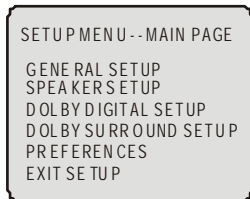
## DVD MENU SETTING

According to the recorded information and external equipment, set the following functions for DVD to obtain the best playing status.

1. Push **SETUP** to set the main menu.

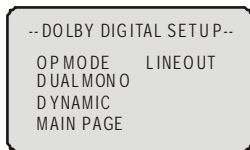
2. Push direction buttons (▲ ▼), and push **PLAY** to confirm.

Example: Select “DOLBY DIGITAL SETUP”.

Push ▼ to select “DOLBY DIGITAL SETUP”.

Push **PLAY** to confirm and enter “DOLBY DIGITAL SETUP”. The screen shows the sub-menu for your selection.

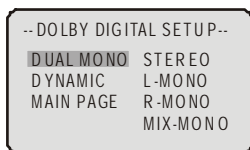

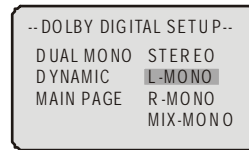

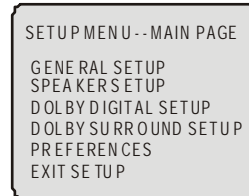

Push the direction button ▼ to select “MAIN PAGE”, push **PLAY** to exit from the current column and return to the main menu.



Push ▼ to select “EXIT SETUP”, then push **PLAY** to exit from the menu.

## TV DISPLAY

### 1. NORMAL/PS

This is selected when the unit is connected with a normal TV.

Wide-screen images are shown on the screen, but with some parts cut automatically.



### 2. NORMAL/LB

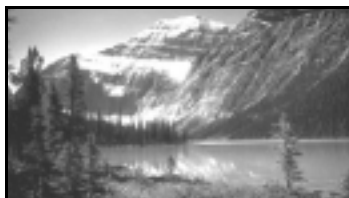
This is selected when the unit is connected with a normal TV.

Wide-screen images are shown on screen, with black belts on the top and bottom.



### 3. WIDE

This is selected when the unit is connected with a wide-screen TV.



## TV TYPE

You may select according to the colour system of the TV to be connected.

- ✧ Select "AUTO" for a multi-system TV.

- ✧ Select "NTSC" for a NTSC TV.
- ✧ Select "PAL" for a PAL TV.

## PIC MODE

- ✧ Select "AUTO" for automatically setup.
- ✧ Select "HI-RES" for high-resolution picture.
- ✧ Select "N-FLICKER" for no flicker picture.

## VIDEO MODE

- ✧ RGB: The OUTPUT is in RGB.
- ✧ YCrCb: The OUTPUT is in YCrCb.
- ✧ VIDEO: The OUTPUT is in VIDEO.

## ANGLE MARK

This only works when there is an angle mark on the disc.

- ✧ Select "ON", the screen shows the mark when playing a DVD.
- ✧ Select "OFF", the mark is not shown.

## OSD LANGUAGE

- ✧ GERMAN: The OSD is in GERMAN.
- ✧ ENGLISH: The OSD is in ENGLISH.
- ✧ FRENCH: The OSD is in FRENCH.
- ✧ ITALIAN: The OSD is in ITALIAN.
- ✧ SPANISH: The OSD is in SPANISH.
- ✧ DUTCH: The OSD is in DUTCH.
- ✧ FINNISH: The OSD is in FINNISH.
- ✧ GREECE: The OSD is in GREECE.

## AUDIO OUT

- ✧ ANALOG: No signal is output from the coaxial or optical port.
- ✧ SPDIF/RAW: Select this when the DVD player is connected with a power amplifier through optical or coaxial port. Please refer to the page 10. When a Dolby Digital DVD, DTS-DVD or MPEG-DVD is played, select this, the coaxial or optical port will output in the corresponding digital format (source code). The power amplifier to be connected must have Dolby Digital, DTS-DVD and MPEG-DVD is played, the optical or coaxial port will output in PCM 2-channel format.
- ✧ SPDIF/PCM: Select this when the DVD player is connected with a TV or a power amplifier through audio cord.

## CAPTIONS

- ✧ ON: The hidden subtitle is shown.
- ✧ OFF: The hidden subtitle is turned off

## SCREEN SAVER

Start the screen saver, the screen saver image appears when the unit stops or the image is motionless for a few minutes. This saver can keep the screen from being damaged.

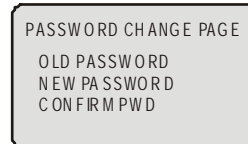

## SELECT LANGUAGE

If a language mentioned above is recorded on the disc, you can select sounds, subtitles or disc menu languages. If not, the first language recorded on the disc is shown.

## PASSWORD SETUP

Select this to adapt the code, the screen shows:



Enter a code according to the screen.

Notes: If you forget your password, the default password of 3308 will still work.

## PARENTAL

The content of a disc with lock function is evaluated by grades.

You can select an age grade as your need.

Example: Select "PG", the scenes of violence inadvisable to children are not played.

For adults, the screen suggests you enter the code after pushing **PLAY**, you can watch if the code is right.

Notes: The password is set by yourself.

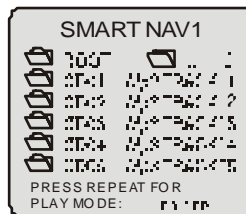

## XI. PLAY MP3

### PLAY MP3 DISC

Choose track number by pressing digital key.

1. Place disc into the tray, the player starts reading disc and show message on screen.
  - a) If the track number is less than 10, directly press 1 to 10 to choose track;
  - b) If the track number is greater than 10 or equal to 10, press 10+ and one key of 0 to 9 to choose track;
  - c) If the number is not shown in the current page, please use key “PREV” or “NEXT” to page up and page down;
2. Choose main page  
After showing the following page, directly press digital number to choose track
3. Choose one track number by using digital key or direction key



## REPEAT playback

- a. Choose track to play;
- b. Press “REPEAT” to choose playback mode “SINGLE”, “FOLDER”
- c. Cancel repeat mode by choose REPEAT OFF’

## OTHER FUNCTION

When playing Mp3 disc, the player can provide the function of mute, volume control, pause, previous track/next track, and channel selection. Please operate it like CDDA playback.

## XII. OTHERS

### TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience the following problems while using the unit, this troubleshooting guide can help you.

#### No sound

- Check if the unit is connected securely.
- Make sure you operate the TV or amplifier correctly.
- Make sure you have selected DVD player position on the amplifier.

#### No image

- Check if the unit is connected securely.
- Make sure you operate the TV correctly.
- Make sure you set the colour system correctly.

#### Bad sound quality

- Make sure the audio output mode is set correctly.
- Make sure the audio connection between the unit and amplifier is right.

#### Image rolls and no colour

- The colour system set by this unit does not match with that of TV. Push **P/N** on the remote control to select needed one.

#### Disc cannot be played

- There is no disc in the unit.
- Put the disc on the disc tray properly with the label side up.
- Clean the disc.
- Moisture has condensed in the unit. Remove the disc and leave the unit on for about one hour.

#### No Phone sound

- Switch on the microphone.
- Turn the MIC LEVEL away knob clockwise.

#### Remote control does not work

- Remove barriers between the remote control and the unit.
- Replace the batteries with new ones.
- Point the remote control at the remote control sensor of the unit.
- Reference page 7.
